- Would question in assessment Test of Certificate Course be subjective or objective? Ans. Question paper will be in objective, containing 50 multiple choice questions carrying 2 marks each. The GST Acts & Rules, 2017 and Rules/ Notifications/Circulars issued till 31st Dec, 2019 would be applicable.
- 3. What is Fees for appearing in Assessment Test? Ans.
