GOODS & SERVICES TAX / IDT UPDATE - 86

Advisory on Opting-in for Composition Scheme for 2020-21 – Extension of Dates in view of COVID-19 pandemic

Team GSTN has issued the following <u>advisory for Composition Scheme</u> dated 07th April,2020 as under:-

A. Due to COVID-19 pandemic and challenges faced by taxpayers, Government has extended dates for opting for composition scheme by normal taxpayers, for the financial year 2020-21. These are notified in <u>Notifications 30/2020</u> Central Tax, dated 03.04.2020. <u>Circular No. 136/06/2020-GST</u> dated 3rd April, 2020 has also been issued.

B. Existing Normal taxpayers who want to opt for Composition Scheme in Financial Year 2020-21 may note following changes:

- 1. **Revised date to file Form GST CMP 02:** Normal and registered taxpayers who want to opt in for Composition in FY 2020-21 can apply in Form GST CMP-02 by 30th June 2020.
- No GSTR 1 or 3B must be filed in 2020-21 financial year for associated <u>PAN</u>: The taxpayers <u>SHOULD NOT</u> file any GSTR-1/GSTR-3B, for any tax period of FY 2020-21, from any of the GSTIN on the associated PAN, or else they will not be able to opt for composition scheme for FY 2020-21.
- 3. <u>No need for re-opting for the composition scheme:</u> The taxpayers who are already in composition scheme, in previous financial year are <u>not required</u> to opt in for composition again for FY 2020-2021.
- 4. **Revised date to file Form GST ITC 03:** Form GST ITC-03 to reverse ITC for the stock in hand at the time of transition can be filed till 31st July, 2020.
- Modification in earlier advisory date 18.02.2020: The advisory issued on 18.02.2020 and available on GST Portal (click here for the link <u>https://www.gst.gov.in/newsandupdates/read/356</u>) <u>stands modified</u> to above extent.
